

ORDINANCE NO. 96-01 (ABC)

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE TOWN OF STERLINGTON TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF HIGH AND LOW CONTENT ON SUNDAY.**

*WHEREAS, a referendum was held within the corporate limits of the Town of Sterlington, Louisiana, which authorizes the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Sterlington to regulate the sale of alcoholic beverages between the hours of 12:00 midnight on Saturday to 12:00 midnight on Sunday.*

*WHEREAS, due and proper notice by publication of the introduction of this ordinance has been made in accordance with the provisions of Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:4712, as last amended, and*

*WHEREAS, since more than thirty (30) days have elapsed since the first publication of the notice of the introduction of this Ordinance and no opposition has been made thereto, such notice having been published three times within thirty (30) days, one week apart, in the News Star, official journal of this municipality, which said notice is attached hereto as an exhibit hereof and made a part hereof by reference.*

**SECTION 1.** *The sale of alcoholic beverages of either high or low content shall be prohibited within the corporate limits of the Town of Sterlington between the hours of 12:00 midnight Saturday night and 12:00 midnight Sunday night.*

**SECTION 2.** *In the event of the invalidity of any part of any section or provision hereof, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.*


**SECTION 3.** *All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Sterlington, Louisiana, that:


