

ORDINANCE NO. 37 (OTG)
Adopted February 11, 1965

PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE HIRING OF POLICE OFFICERS, FIXING OF THEIR COMPENSATION AND FIXING OF GENERAL DUTIES OF POLICE OFFICERS.

A Police Department is hereby established for the Town of Sterlington and the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, at their discretion and as the need arises, have full power and authority to appoint, uniform and commission a police force and to appoint as many police officers as may be necessary; to fix the salaries and compensation of all officers so appointed or selected by them; that the police officers so appointed shall be conservators of the peace and that it shall be said police officers' duty to bring order, quiet disturbances and bring before the proper authority all persons charged with violating any city act, law or ordinance.
