

ORDINANCE #89-05 (OTG)

AN ORDINANCE TO EXPAND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF STERLINGTON.

WHEREAS persons and corporations owning more than 25% in assessed value and being more than 25% in number of the owners of land situated along the South side of Highway 2 from the boundary of Johnson and Johnson Westward to the Southwest point of property belonging to the Sterlington Sewerage District No. 1 and thence Northward to the present Town limits of Sterlington have signed a petition requesting that the said property (as more fully shown on survey of Terry Denmon and Associates dated May 15, 1989, attached hereto and made a part hereof) be incorporated into the Town of Sterlington pursuant to R.S. 33:172 et seq., and

WHEREAS the land in question includes several parcels already belonging to the Town of Sterlington and/or Sewerage Districts serving the Town, and

WHEREAS the Town limits now bisect several properties and buildings in such manner as to raise questions of the Town's taxing and other authority in connection with these properties, and


WHEREAS the extension of Town limits sought in the petition is considered by the Board of Aldermen to be reasonable and proper and in the best interests of all the citizens of Sterlington,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT THE TOWN LIMITS OF STERLINGTON BE AND THEY ARE HEREBY AMENDED AND EXTENDED TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY.

The foregoing ordinance having been duly introduced at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, Town of Sterlington and the notice of it having been published in the official journal pursuant to R.S. 33:406, and the same having been read by title at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on May 16, 1989, and called for final passage and submitted to a final vote as a whole thereon being:


