

ORDINANCE NO. 93-02 (OTG)

TO ESTABLISH POLICIES RELATIVE TO WORK HOURS, PAYMENT OF WAGES, AND APPROVAL AND PAYMENT OF OVERTIME FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF STERLINGTON POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Sterlington, Louisiana:


That all employees of the Town of Sterlington Police Department shall be paid at an hourly rate at the particular rate of pay a rate approved for each particular employee, from time to time, by the Board of Aldermen. Each such employee shall be paid semi-monthly. Overtime compensation shall be paid at the standard hourly pay for each employee, and no work shall be performed by any such employee beyond a 40 hour work week, unless expressly approved by the Chief of Police prior to it being incurred. Employees are to be paid on the 15th and last day of each month.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
