

-ORDINANCE NO 95-~~04~~(DTG)

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING AND INCORPORATING THE A.L. SMITH SCHOOL PROPERTY INTO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF STERLINGTON.

Be it ordained that in accordance with the Petition submitted by the Ouachita Parish School Board, requesting the the annexation of the parcel of property described hereafter (hereafter referred to as A.L. Smith School Property) of which the Petitioner is the record holder of title. It is hereby ordained in accordance with LSA-R.S. 33:180 that the property described as follows:

A certain tract or parcel of land, situated in Ouachita Parish in Lot No. 1 of Section 29, Township 20 North, Range 4 East, more particularly described as:


Beginning at the Northwest Corner of Section 38, of said Township and Range, run south 62°35' west a distance of 12.5 feet; thence north 27°20' a distance of 25 feet to an iron post which said post is the Southeast corner of said lot; thence south 62°35' west a distance of 315.3 feet to an iron post which is the Southwest corner of said triangular lot of land; thence North 15°,42' East for a distance of 443.7 feet to an iron post which is the North angle corner of said lot; thence South 29°35' East a distance of 322.5 feet to the place of beginning. This lot containing 1.168 acres and more particularly shown on plat of same made by S.M. Collins, C.E., filed in the office of the Clerk of Court for Ouachita Parish, Louisiana, being the same property acquired by the Ouachita Parish School Board in that instrument filed in and for Record of Ouachita Parish, Louisiana, on February 18, 1930, as instrument #133222.


be and hereby is annexed and incorporated into the corporate limits of the Town of Sterlington, State of Louisiana.
