

ORDINANCE NO. 99-02 (OTG)

AN ORDINANCE RECINDING ORDINANCE NO. 95-02 (OTG) AND CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENTS FOR NON-ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND COMPENSATION OF THE CLERK, TAX COLLECTOR, TOWN ATTORNEY AND COURT MAGISTRATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF STERLINGTON, hereby confirms and approve the appointment of Chris Cox as Mayor Pro Tempore, Connie Smith as Street and Drainage Commissioner, Ron Hill to serve as Commissioner of Bartholomew Sewer District #1, Marilyn Dilmore as Town Clerk and Tax Collector, Edward “Dion” Young as Town Attorney and Jimmy White as Court Magistrate.

FURTHERMORE, the compensation shall be fixed for the Clerk/Tax Collector, the Town Attorney, and the Court Magistrate:

Town Clerk/ Tax Collector - \$8.95 hourly, plus \$150 monthly for Employee Benefit.

Town Attorney - \$100 hourly.

Court Magistrate - \$100 hourly.

Mayor Pro Tempore – no compensation other than Aldermen’s compensation.

Street and Drainage Commissioner – no compensation.

Bartholomew Sewer Commissioner – no compensation.

The foregoing ordinance having been duly introduced at a regular meeting on January 19, 1999 of the mayor and Board of Aldermen, Town of Sterlington and the notice of it having been published in the official journal pursuant to R.S. 33:381, and the same having been read by title at the regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on February 16, 1999 and called for final passage and submitted to a final vote as a whole, the vote thereon being:
